

## 2021 APPLICATION INFORMATION

## Pettipaug Sailing Academy

Sailing classes are designed for junior sailors age 8 to 18, regardless of previous sailing experience. Certified US Sailing Instructors trained in CPR and First Aid will stress basic sailing skills, seamanship, sportsmanship and the fun of sailing. More advanced students will learn the finer points of boat handling, racing tactics, and may be offered the opportunity to participate in inter-club racing.

### Class Schedules

The Sailing Academy program runs for **three (2) week sessions**. The **first** session is from **June 28 to July 9**, the **second** session is from **July 12 to July 23** and the **third** session is from **July 26 to August 6**. Classes are held Monday through Friday in two sessions: **Morning**, **8:30-12:00** and **Afternoon**, **12:30-4:00**. Students may request either the morning or afternoon session. Morning classes are best for beginners and students eleven and younger. Afternoon classes are better suited for more experienced sailors, usually age twelve and older. Sailing group assignments are based on experience, friendships and student comfort.

#### **Tuition**

Tuition for each session is \$375. There is a \$75 a session discount for using your own boat. Payment can be made by check or PayPal.
